
## Learners of the Week

#### SCHOOL CONCERT

#### **TRANSITION DAYS**

#### SENIOR SCHOOL SLEEPOVER.

The grade 3-6 sleepover will take place on Thursday 15th December in the Blue and Orange room. Students will need to go home for a shower before the sleepover and return to school at 5.30pm.
