CONCERT

STATEWIDE TRANSITION DAY

This year the statewide transition day will be on **Tuesday 12th December**. Grade 6 students will spend the day at their nominated high school and we will be inviting our 2024 prep students back to school for the morning, where we will move into our new classes.

GRADE SIX GRADUATION EVENING

Our grade 6 graduation evening will be happening 5.00pm **Thursday 14**th **of December**. The official part of this evening will take place at school, with speeches from each of our graduating students, gifts and celebratory cake. Family members are all welcome to attend for the ceremony.

LAST DAY FOR STUDENTS:

The last day for students is **Tuesday 19th December** and school will finish at 2.30pm on this day. **A WORKING BEE** starting at 10am, for any parents who are able to come and help us get our school yard tidy for the holidays. Jobs we need to get done include spreading out some gravel around our vegetable garden and mud kitchen, weeding and mulching gardens, cleaning up bark and branches from trees and moving soft fall onto the playground areas. We will need shovels, rakes and wheelbarrows for the day, if anyone has any spare. At 12.30pm we will have A SAUSAGE SIZZLE for helpers, staff and students, followed by a final tidy up of classrooms before our WHOLE SCHOOL WATERFIGHT at 1.30pm.

Students will need to bring bathers or clothing that is appropriate for getting wet; this must be Sunsmart. They will also need footwear that can get wet- this can be old sneakers- and a change of clothes and towel. We encourage students to bring their own water pistols, water balloons or other devices, to use in the water fight, as the school has a very limited supply, but please make sure these are not high pressure. Students do not have to participate in the water fight if they prefer not to and an alternative quiet activity will be provided for them inside.


