IMPORTANT SAFETY INFORMATION: CAR PARK AND PICK-UP TIME

PLEASE READ THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION CAREFULLY

Students have been instructed not to leave the school grounds until the staff member on gate duty arrives at the bus shelter to let them out.

Due to the increased number of staff and families at the school, the carpark can be quite congested at pickup time. If you need to park across the road, please walk over and collect your child

When pulling in and out of car park, please be aware of students and families who may be crossing the road around you or parked behind you.
