IMPORTANT SAFETY INFORMATION: CAR PARK AND PICK-UP TIME

PLEASE READ THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION CAREFULLY

- Students have been instructed not to leave the school grounds until the staff member on gate duty arrives at the bus shelter to let them out.
- Due to the increased number of staff and families at the school, the carpark can be quite congested at pickup time. If you need to park across the road, please walk across the road to collect your child.
- When pulling in and out of car park, please be aware of students and families who may be crossing the road around you or parked behind you.
- When coming around the corner into Crofts Road, please be aware that cars may be parked close to the corner so please SLOW down.
- Please also be aware that the gate area is a No Smoking Zone for 4 metres each way. This is to protect staff, students and parents, especially those with health conditions such as Asthma, which can be triggered by smoke that is lingering around in the area. The gate area also becomes congested so please move away from this space as soon as you have collected your children.
